- I am aware that Karate-Do is primarily a martial art, and I agree to act responsibly. I shall NOT misuse it under any circumstances. I will use my martial arts skills only in cases of danger or emergency for self-defense and the protection of my family & nation, in accordance with the laws of the land.
- I will not indulge in any unlawful activity or any action that may harm others, damage the prestige and honor of Karate-Do, or bring disrepute to JKKI or the institution where training is conducted.

Class Schedules & Training Regulations

JKKI reserves the right to modify class schedules when necessary. This may include:

Adjustments to the current class schedule.

Closing the dojo on public holidays, for special karate events, meetings, or any other reason.

Changes in training batches based on the number of students.

Fee Policy:

Students are required to pay training fees in full every month, even if they miss classes.

No refunds will be given once fees are paid.

Physical Contact During Training:

I understand and accept that physical contact may occur during training, testing, demonstrations, competitions, seminars, and first aid situations. This contact is essential for martial arts training and self-defense techniques.

Equipment & Safety Regulations

Students must bring their Karate-Do Uniform and complete Karate Kit, including:

Gloves, Shin pads, Headgear, Chest guard, Gum shield

JKKI does not guarantee that protective equipment will eliminate the risk of injury. However, it reduces the chances of accidents. I recognize the possibility of injury and fully accept the risks associated with martial arts training. JKKI, its instructors, technical directors, officials, and volunteers are NOT responsible for any injuries, mishaps, or loss of life.

Training & Conduct Regulations

Students must:

Respect instructors, senior members, and fellow students.

Follow JKKI's syllabus, training structure, and grading system.

Maintain discipline, sincerity, and loyalty towards JKKI and its instructors.

Participate in Kyu/Dan grade exams, competitions, training camps, seminars, and workshops, which are mandatory.

Strictly Prohibited:

Sharing knowledge with members of other karate styles.

Teaching martial arts without written permission from Hanshi Gireesh Perumthatta (Technical Director of JKKI).

Disciplinary Actions:

Violation of JKKI's rules, misconduct, or involvement in illegal activities may lead to suspension, expulsion, or legal action.
